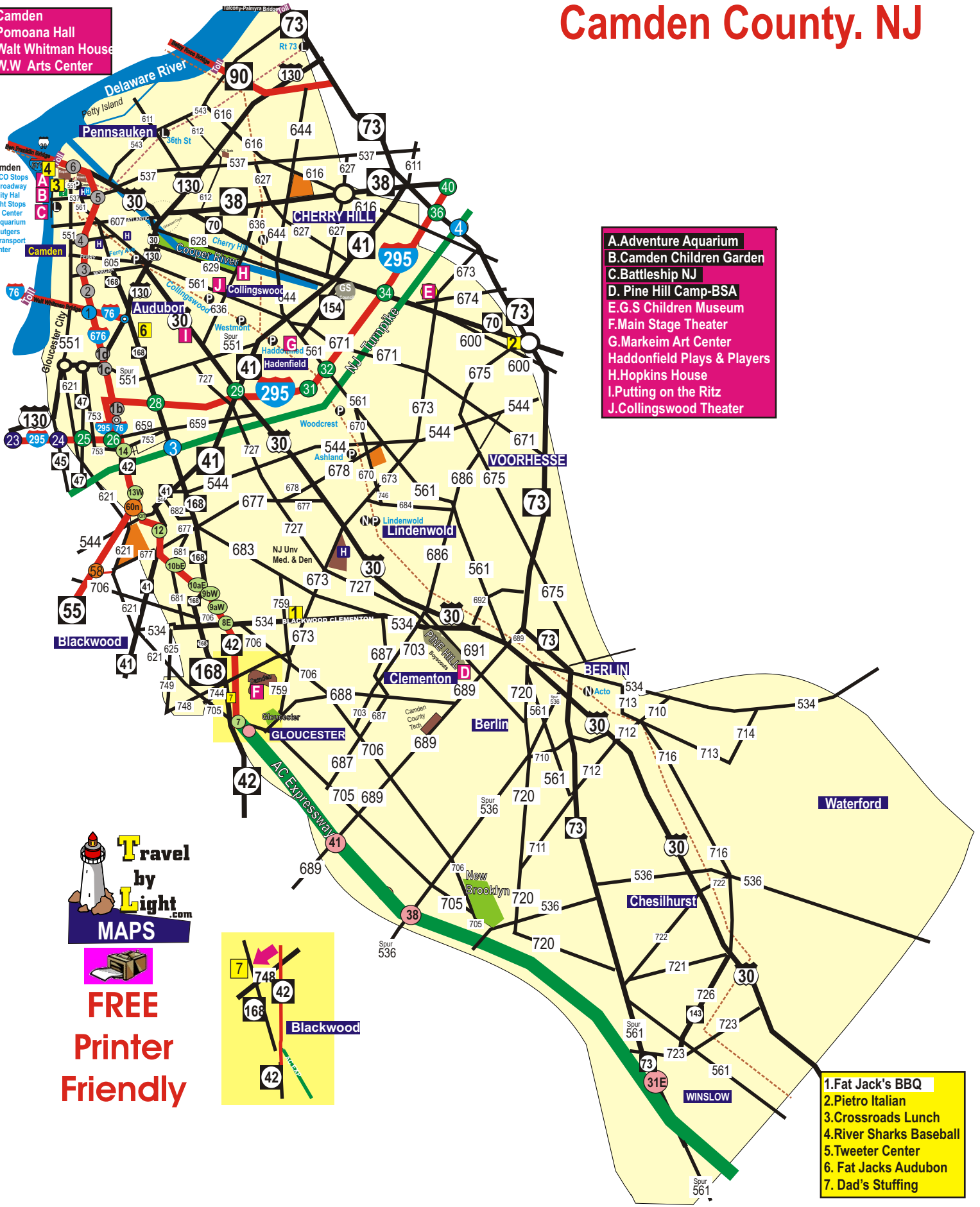

0C Battleship NJ

One of the largest battleships ever built, the USS New Jersey was first launched on December 7, 1942 and commissioned for service in World War II, the Korean War, Vietnam and for service as part of President Reagan's 600 ship Navy. She completed her final voyage on Veteran's Day 1999 as she arrived at the former Philadelphia Naval Ship Yard on the Delaware River along the Camden Waterfront. Now this country's most decorated ship is a floating museum where history comes to life as visitors experience a two-hour guided tour through the lowa-class ship. My husband is a fanatic when it comes to eating ribs, and he rates Fat Jack's pork ribs as tied for first place out of everywhere he's been across the United States. During your initial visit to Fat Jacks, I recommend that you start off with their Jammin' Jambalaya or their Buzzard Breath Chili. Then, for the main course, go with the rack of Pork Ribs. I suggest that you order them dry with the sauce on the side. Then, to complement the ribs, you definitely want to get the Smashed Potatoes, Southern green beans and the BBQ beans. All platters are served with fresh homemade cornbread.
