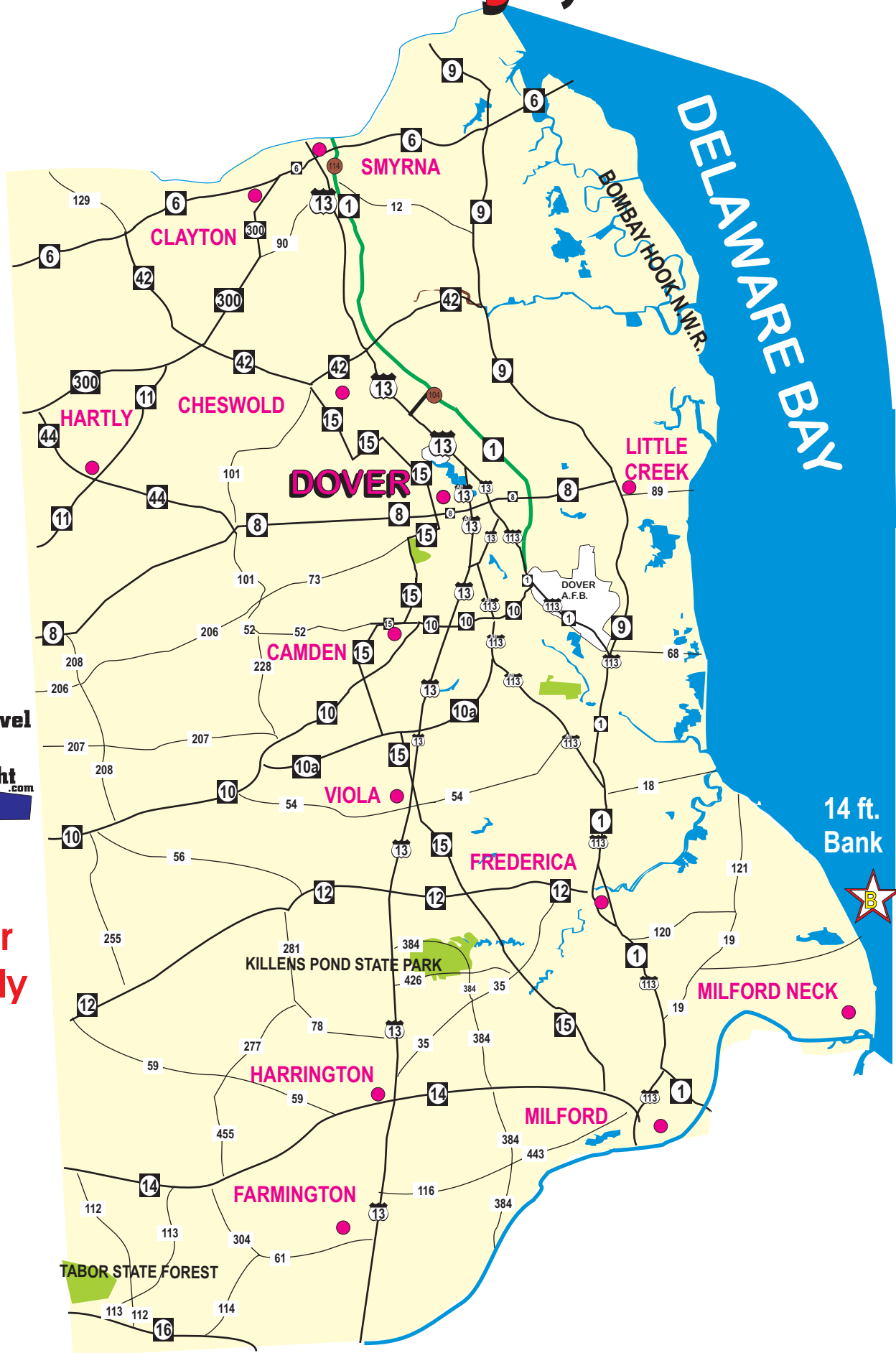
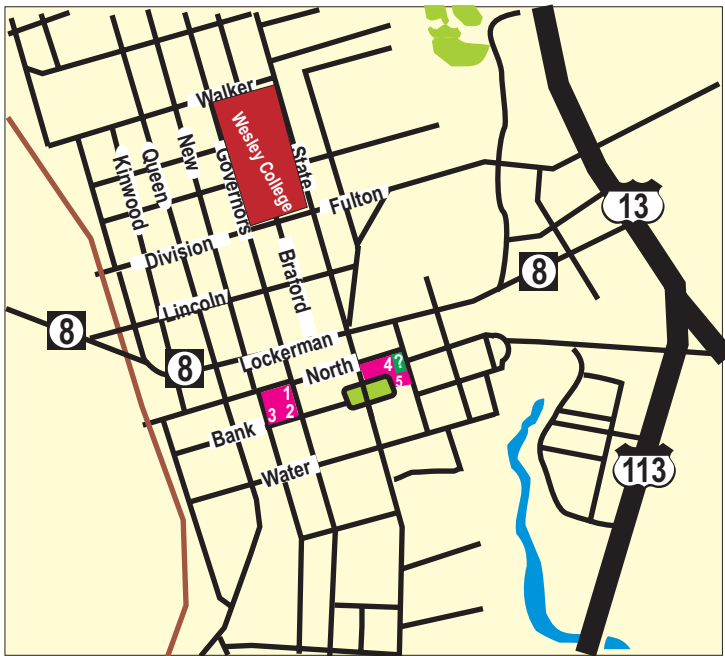

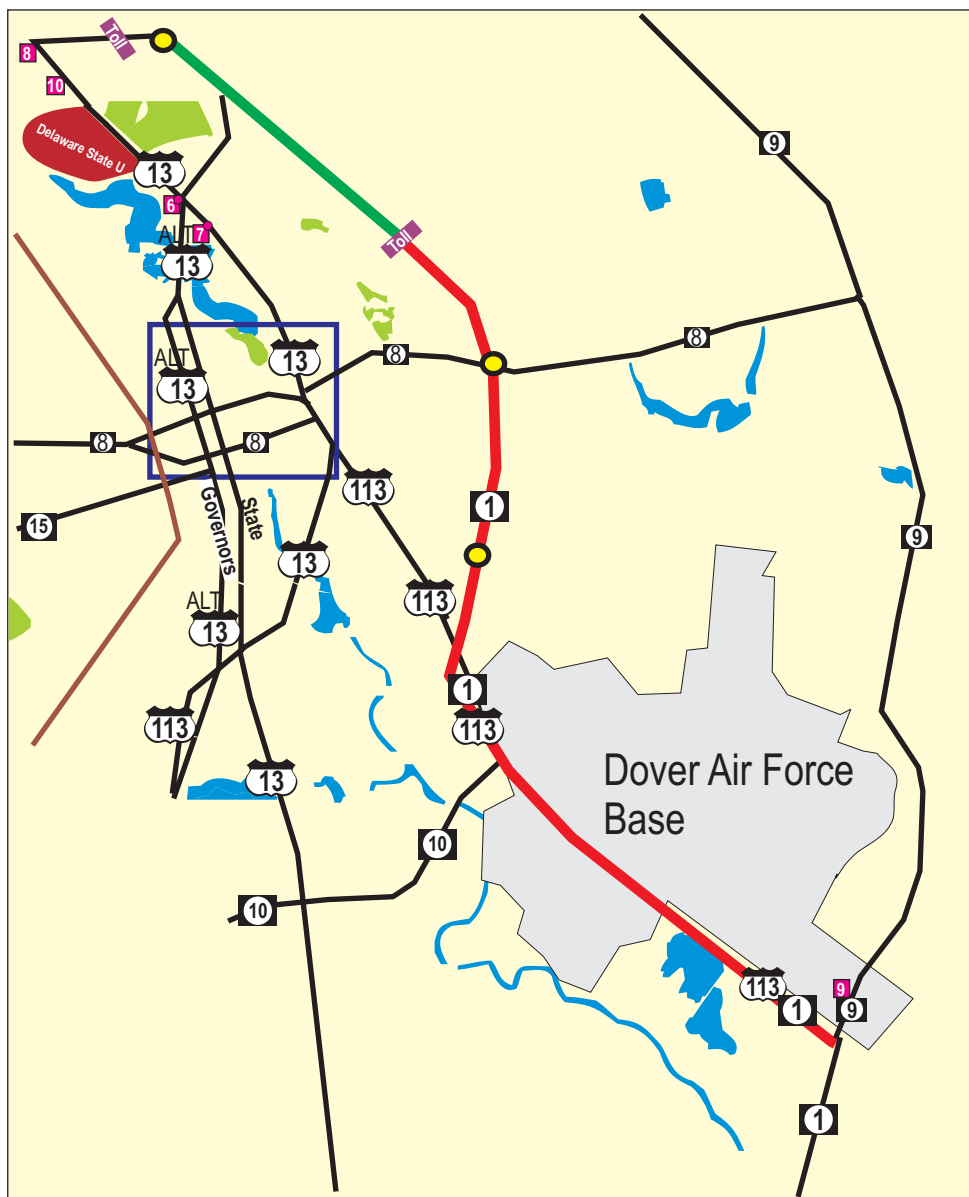

Air Mobility Command Museum

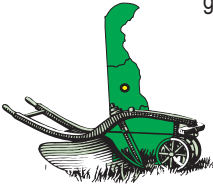
The Air Mobility Command Museum is dedicated to restoring and displaying the proud symbols of America's ingenuity and might, and interpreting the stories they tell. The museum preserves military airlift and tanker aircraft, as these planes were an important part of military aviation history. Displays featured in the museum include Enlisted Personnel, an Aircraft Timeline, and the Tuskegee Airmen. In their hanger visitors can also experience a remarkable selection of exhibits including the Woman's Air Service Pilots, a Korean War Memorial, a display of the Berlin Airlift highlighting the many services the United States provided the city, the Hadrian which was the most widely used WWII cargo and assault glider, the Fourth Fighter Group Nose Art Collection which sought to instill camaraderie, a flight simulator containing hundreds of knobs, dials, toggle switches, and lights, the HH-43 helicopter exhibit, the "Hall of Heroes" exhibit recounts the stories of many of America's Medal of Honor recipients and the What are Aircrafts Made Of and the Wing Construction Exhibits educate visitors on the construction of aircraft. Be sure to bring the kids (even the bigger, older, adult ones!) as there is a lot of captivating things to see at the Air Mobility Command Museum. (Kent)

The Delaware Agricultural Museum and Village

The Delaware Agricultural Museum and Village is dedicated to the preservation of Delmarva's rural heritage. A main exhibit building and fifteen historic structures associated with a nineteenth century farming community bring the fascinating story of agriculture to life. More than 4,000 artifacts are displayed in the main exhibit building - from butter churns to threshers, from an eighteenth century log house to the first broiler chicken house. Their awesome historic buildings and exhibits collectively illustrate a day in the life of a nineteenth century farmer. Since its opening, more than 400,000 visitors have toured the museum and learned about Delmarva's agricultural history through long-term exhibitions focusing on grain harvesting, the evolution of the tractor, and the poultry, produce and dairy industries. Temporary exhibits offer insights into other facets of rural life. In addition, the Museum hosts a number of annual special events that highlight the activities of nineteenth century farmers. For the child who believes milk comes from the grocery store instead of a cow, for the woman who remembers using a cornsheller on her grandmother's farm, the family who takes twentieth century technological advances and the farmer for granted, the Delaware Agricultural Museum and Village offers a memorable and educational experience.

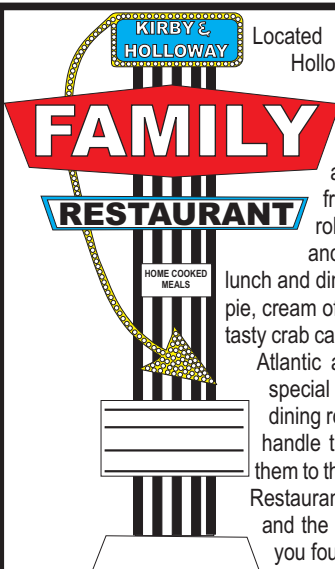
